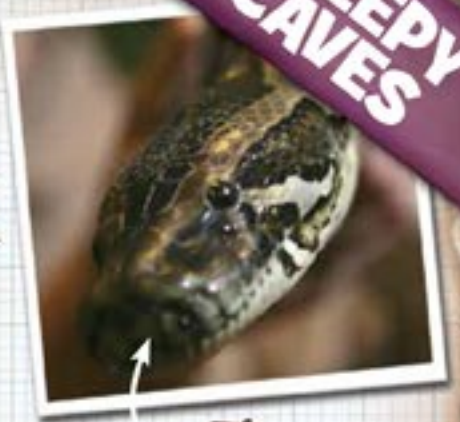

CREEPY CAVES

SRI LANKA PYTHONS

are constrictors and are not venomous. These snakes can grow up to 4 metres long. They eat small mammals which they swallow whole.

come from Africa and are also known as "giant one-horned chameleons". They eat insects which they catch with their very long and fast tongue.

MACAWS

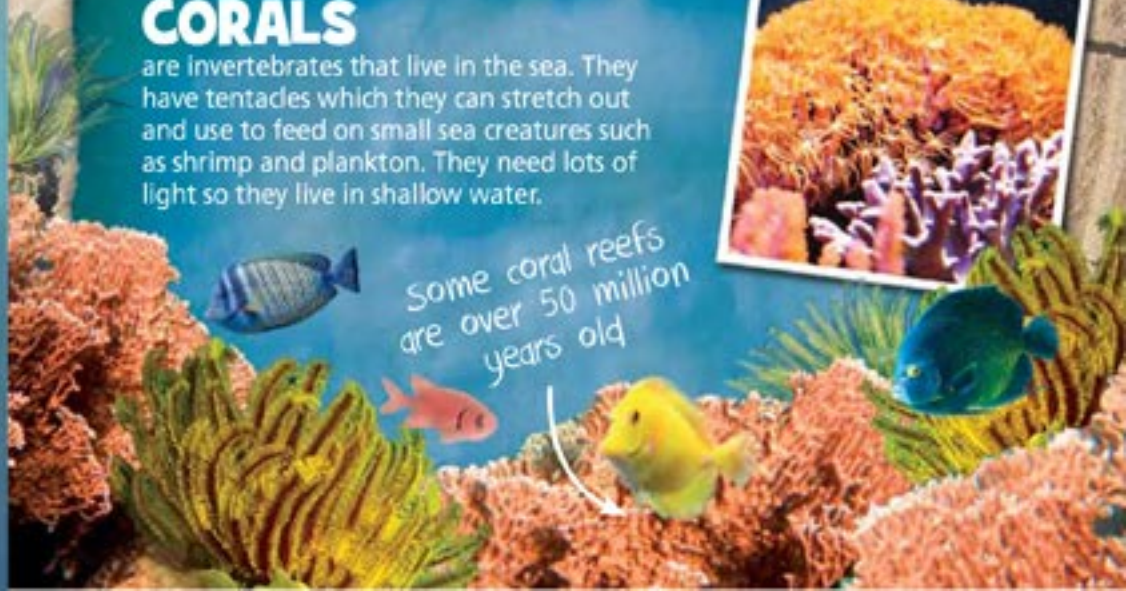
Seahorses can move their eyes separately so they can look forwards and backwards at the same time!

are invertebrates that live in the sea. They have tentacles which they can stretch out and use to feed on small sea creatures such as shrimp and plankton. They need lots of light so they live in shallow water.

come from South America and make their nests on the rocky shores using guano (bird pool!). All our penguins have different spot patterns, just like humans all have different fingerprints.

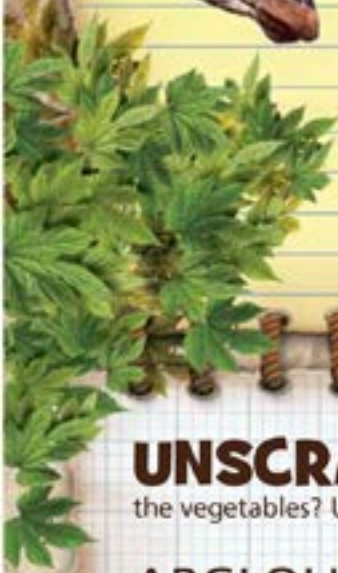
