Ensuring diversity of viewpoints in collective leadership

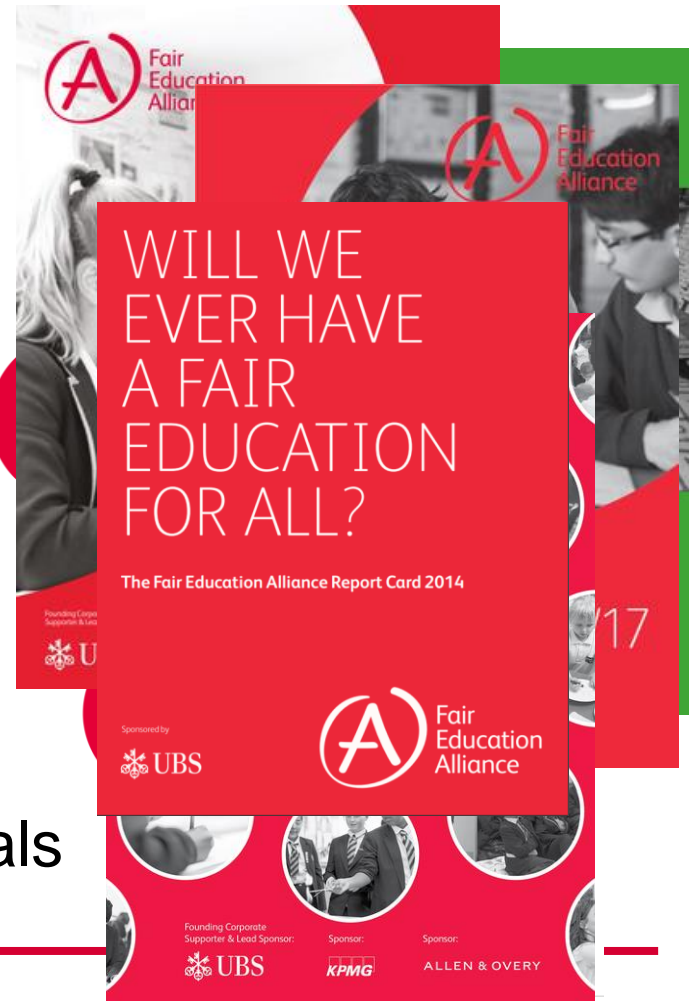
Building consensus on what needs to change, and how, across organisations
