## **Easter Holiday Challenges**

How many words can you make from the letters in 'EASTER HOLIDAYS'?  1 hour	Go to the national Children's University website and complete the 'Money Matters' downloadable activity.  https://www.childrensuniversity.co. uk/ get-involved/activities-to-do-at-home-and-online/  1 hour	Write a newspaper report about a local issue that you feel strongly about. Talk about how this impacts on you, your family and your community.  1 hour	Make a poster about why it is important to have a balanced diet and why you should exercise regularly.  1 hour
Write a poem about a topic / theme of your choice.  1 hour	Write your own mini story about an exciting adventure. Don't forget to include pictures! 1 hour	Make an Easter card and post it to someone in your family or to a friend.  1 hour	Find an Easter or Spring themed recipe and cook or bake a tasty treat. Write down the ingredients and method. Don't forget to take a picture!
The Easter Bunny. What about other famous rabbits? Find out about another famous rabbit. Write about why they are famous and where their character comes from. Draw a picture of them too.  1 hour	Get Growing!  Plant some cress seeds or beans. Watch the roots and leaves grow or you could even plant a sunflower.  Make sure you send us a picture and a description of what you did and what happened.  1 hour	Create an anti-littering poster.  1 hour	Design your own house.  Draw and write what you would like in it and also what you would do to help the environment.  1 hour
Draw a portrait of someone famous or someone you live with.  1 hour	Write down a place you would like to visit listing 3 interesting facts about it.  1 hour	Work undercover! Come up with a secret code so that you can send secret messages! You can use numbers, letters, pictures. Ask someone to crack the code once you have done it!  1 hour	Create a game or board game to play with your family. <b>1 hour</b>
