

Children's University Online:

Validating an activity

For your learning destinations to add their activity to Children's University Online they will first need to fill out a form which can be found on our website under *Get involved*.

Once the form has been submitted you will be able to validate and generate a stamp code through your dashboard.

Children's University managers are responsible for validating activities in their local area. Children's University Trust is responsible for validating national learning destinations.

What you'll need

• Your Children's University Online log in

Step 1

• Go to <u>www.childrensuniversity.co.uk</u> and look for the word 'Login' at the top right. Choose to login as staff and enter your details, your username will be your email address and your password will have been sent to you by Children's University Trust (remember to check your junk folder!)

Step 2

• Once you have logged on you will be taken to your *Dashboard*. You will see *Activities* click on *Awaiting Validation*

Step 3

• Once you have clicked on Awaiting Validation you will be taken to a view where you can see all the activities that are awaiting validation. You will see different options. Please click on validate



Step 4

• You will be taken to an overview of the activity application submitted by the learning destination. You will need to read through this carefully and ensure that the activity submitted is suitable and adheres to Children's University guidelines. Pay special attention to the skills and categories tagged, this data will populate reports and feed into the child's dashboard.

Step 5

• Once you have read through all the information and spoken to the learning destination you can tick the boxes as shown below and click *Save as Validated* this will take you to the next step which is to generate a stamp code. Please see the Help page for a step by step guide on generating stamp codes for your learning destination
